The process to follow for Reciprocal players;

The player must complete the reciprocal player form and send it to the clubs and states involved for approval. Once signed they will need to bank the fees that are required and pay the \$10 PAA fee and then the states player fee.

ALL SDU to see and approve all reciprocal players coming into any Clubs. This will make sure he knows who is doing what and can keep his own list of players.

The Players club will need to nominate the player as an interstate pool player on the database for any carnivals they will attend.

This must be done prior to the database carnival close off.

The player must also nominate with their reciprocal club to play at a carnival so they can be selected into a team.

The interstate Reciprocal Club will then nominate their club teams and pool players on the database as per usual but leave a blank spot in the team nomination if a reciprocal player is to play in that team.

The interstate Reciprocal Club must then email the host club of the carnival, the SDU & NDU advising what team the reciprocal player will be playing in. This must be done prior to the carnival close off of nominations.
